From the Office

Sickness Reminder

If your child is vomiting or has diarrhea, they must stay off school for 48 hours from the last episode. This ensures the good health of all the children in school.

Absences

If your child is absent from school you MUST contact the school office by 9.00am. If we have not had contact with you this will result in the school having to contact all members of your contact group. If this is not successful, a home visit, then either the police and/or social services will be contacted. We have a duty of care to ensure your child and the family are safe.

Out of School Clubs

For safeguarding purposes, if your child is unable to attend a club please let the office know or send a text to 0161 850 0004.

Staff are regularly reminding children of the following, parents/carers may also want to speak to their children about doing the following:

- Wash their hands often, with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, particularly:
 - Before leaving home, on arrival at school, after using the toilet, after breaks and sporting activities, before preparing food, before eating any food, including snacks, before leaving school.
- If soap and water aren't available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover their cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in a bin.
- Avoid close contact with people who are unwell.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- If they're worried about their symptoms or those of a child, call NHS 111 and don't go directly to their GP or other healthcare environments.

Dear Parents/Carers

As you may be aware a case of COVID-19 (also known as coronavirus) has been confirmed in Tameside. Clearly this is a concerning time for residents and parents but I would like to reassure you that the information provided to school from the Local Authority is that the risk to the individuals remains low.

Please be assured that Public Health England (PHE) have been contacting those who have been in close contact with the resident and will advise any individuals or workplaces on any action required. Anyone who is not contacted by PHE does therefore not need to take any action at this time other than following the good general hygiene advice at www.nhs.uk/coronavirus

We are working closely with the local authority and PHE and receiving regular updated guidance.

PHE have assessed the risk and confirmed that there is currently no information to suggest that there is any increased health risk to any of the borough's school pupils or staff and no public health reason for any schools to close or for staff/pupils not to attend.

We will of course keep you updated of any changes to the situation or new guidance and advice, any changes to current advice that parents need to be made aware of will be emailed out and posted on the school's twitter page and school website.

Of those who catch coronavirus, the great majority will have a mild-to-moderate illness – similar to flu. However, we do need to protect ourselves and our community – particularly older people and those with pre-existing health conditions. As I am sure you aware, guidance advises that a simple and effective way to protect yourself and others from coronavirus is by making sure you wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and if you are unwell make sure you catch your coughs and sneezes in a tissue, throw the tissues away, then wash your hands. School staff are providing children with plentiful reminders of this and there are additional resources in school to support with this.


