3. Miss Adamson shared meeting routines.
4. **Year 4:** toy project, camping project, international friendship  
**Year 3** – providing books to homeless people, clothes collection for homeless people  
**Year 5** – helping another school from a different country, children would like the option of litter picking daily even if it isn't their turn  
**Year 6** – clean up crew for classrooms, redecorate the adventure playground, tripping on logs near the adventure playground so these need looking at  
**Year 2** – start doing the stalls for charity again, school discos

- 5) Charity stalls – school councillors to speak to Miss Fildes about starting charity stall again
- 6) Valentines Day Disco – book a DJ, letter for parents, begin to ask for parent helpers
