Thank you to Reverend David for leading collective worship on Tuesday. He talked about baptism and the 3 symbols of baptism.



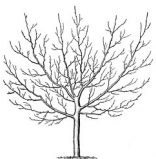
Congratulations to Miss Riley on the birth of her son, Jayson.
