Safeguarding

Out of School Clubs

Autumn Term Clubs

Autumn term clubs will start in the week beginning Monday September 9th.

Lots of places have already been booked for Autumn term out of school clubs, but there are still spaces available on some clubs. The app is open until August 18th. To book a place on Young Engineers, parents need to sign up directly at www.stemkids.co.uk. **If there is no payment option for a club on the app, it means that there are no spaces left on that club.** Payment options will only show when there are spaces left.

There is an amendment to Tuesday gymnastics, there is no club on Tuesday 8th October, this will now be an 11 week course and the cost will be £44.

There are a couple of spaces in Keyboard club at lunchtime, these places are being opened up to yr 4 children. Cost for the term is £33. The children will need a keyboard book to work from which costs £8.50 payable to the teacher in September.
