1. Miss Adamson welcomed the school council and we shared a prayer.
2. Miss Adamson shared the pupil questionnaire feedback from October with the council. We discussed some of the areas where the percentages were lower.

Behaviour – the school council felt that behaviour has improved since October but some classes have more behaviour needs than others.

New buddy stop for KS1 playground is needed.

Homework – some children spoke about the fact that they felt that some people don't always do their homework. We discussed reasons for this. They included that some of them may have forgotten their passwords. We had a discussion about where people kept their passwords. In all but one class, they said that the class teachers hand out paper copies of the homework as well as put it on Google classrooms to ensure that everyone is able to access it.

3. There was a very lengthy discussion surrounding the Easter Disco. Ideas shared included:

 - Hold the raffle outside on the Friday afternoon
5. The councillors shared some further ideas for Arts Week.
- Each class to focus on their own movie
 - Watch their movie
 - Music quiz
 - Draw scenes from movies
 - Design and make new characters
 - Red carpet event
 - Oscar awards event
 - Dress up as movie characters
 - Design masks
 - Make movies
 - Make food from movies
 - Create scripts
 - Design heroes and villains
6. We discussed relaunching the Friendship Project and what friendships worked well last time. The children felt that the care homes, charities, children's ward, refugee camps and children's homes. Miss Adamson will investigate.

Actions:
